Don't forget to Vote!

Ballots will be mailed to all registered voters beginning June 6. Voters affiliated as Republicans or Democrats will receive a ballot for that party. Unaffiliated voters will receive a ballot packet with both the Republican and Democratic ballots unless a

preference was made for a Republican or Democratic ballot. Each voter must choose only one ballot, vote only one ballot, and return only one ballot. If both ballots in the packet are voted and returned, neither ballot is counted.

Return ballots by mail — (affix a \$0.58 stamp). It is recommended that you put your ballot in the mail by June 17, but no later than June 20 if you want to make sure the ballot is delivered to the County Clerk's office by June 28.
